#### **Materials**

Oil, watercolour, acrylic, pastel, crayon, pencil or ink, **only original work accepted** - no photographs or computer generated images and **no writing on the picture**.

Collage is not encouraged but may be accepted at the discretion of the judges.

No glitter at all and no canvas or board before Year 9 (4eme).

#### **Size of Paper**

From MS to CM2 - A4 From 6ème to Terminale - Up to A3

## Labelling of Work & Entry Fee

A completed entry form (as provided by the APL) with the entry fee of £2 in cash taped to it (for the benefit of UCL, Institute of Child Health Great Ormond Street Hospital), must be attached to the back of each work.

All entries must be received by APL **by Friday 12th January 2024.** Artworks need to be returned either to the school office (primary schools) or the vie scolaire (college, lycee & British Section).
