- Population of 8.5 million
- Largest province (by area) in Canada

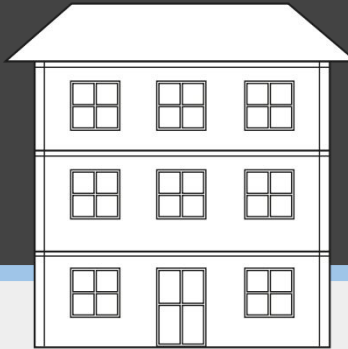

Deadline for **international** students to apply and be considered for Fall entry (High School, College and University transfers) & Competitive Scholarships and Awards and Bursaries application deadline.

June 15

Residence application deadline.

Required Documents: Copy of all relevant score reports (*predicted scores are acceptable*)

- We will also accept any supplemental documentation a student wishes to submit (CV, Personal Statement, etc.) but it's NOT required

Rolling Admission: You could receive an answer from us within 10-15 Business Days of applying

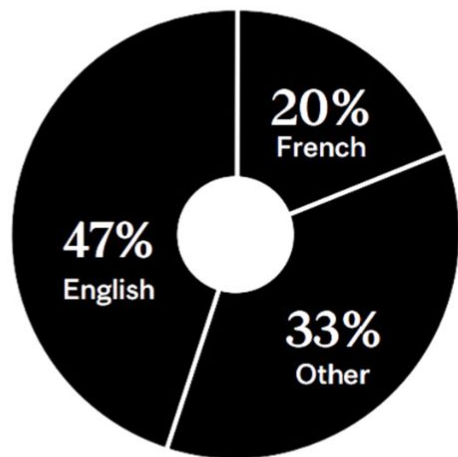

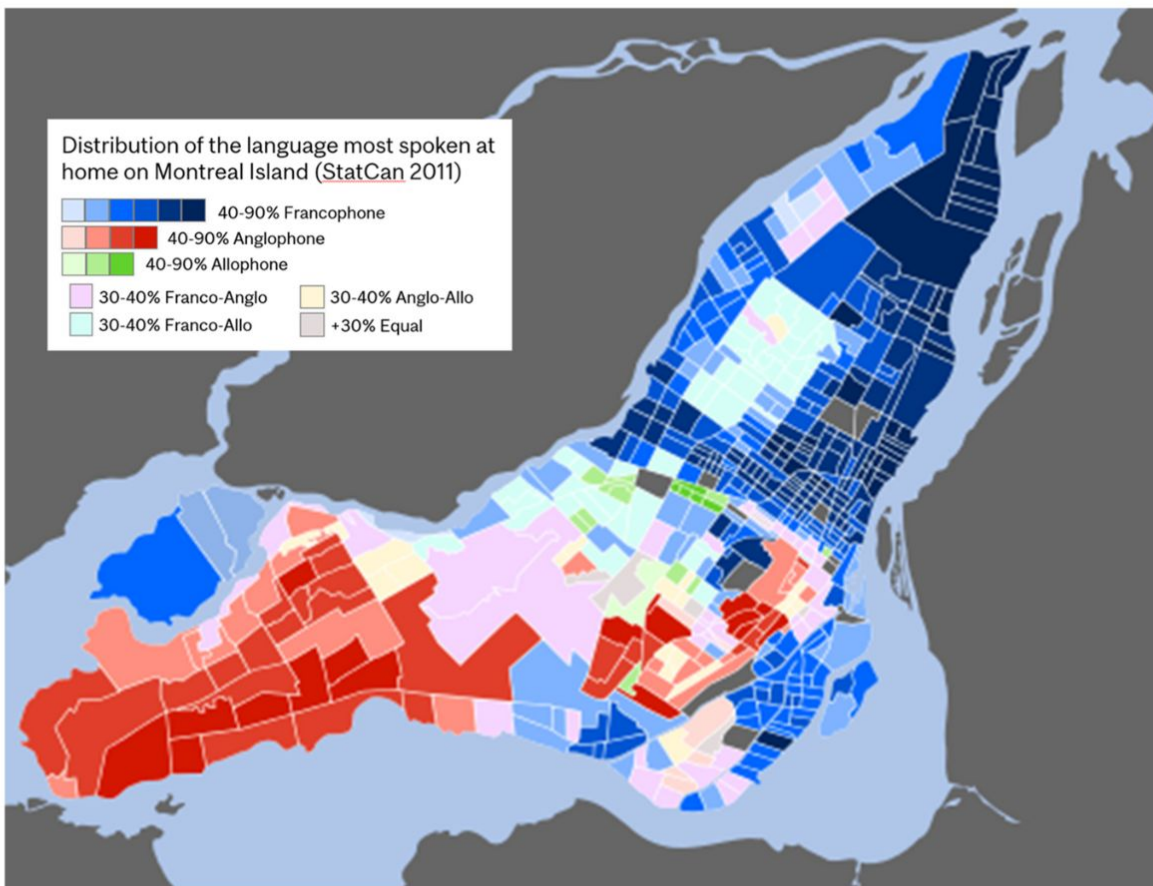

Application

October 1st to January 15th

- One application fee for two program selections
- Opt-in for residence during application

Supporting documents

Deadline March 1st

- Transcripts
- Proof of English proficiency, if required

No statement of purpose, reference letters, essays or extracurricular information.
